**Appointment Waiver Enhancements (I-601)  
U.S. Consulate Ciudad Juarez  
Waiver Pilot Program**

Some persons who have been found ineligible for an immigrant visa under the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA) may file an Application for Waiver of Ground of Inadmissibility (I-601). Findings of ineligibility are made by a Consular Officer during an immigrant visa interview.

The USCIS Field Office along with the U.S. Consulate General in Ciudad Juarez provides same day adjudication of many *I-601* Waivers of Inadmissibility as part of an ongoing pilot program. To enhance service to waiver applicants, we have transitioned the provision of waiver information and the scheduling of waiver appointments to the Mexico based Call Center. This is the same company that currently provides information regarding immigrant and non-immigrant visas.

As of December 17, immigrant visa applicants seeking a waiver of inadmissibility will be required to call the numbers listed below to obtain information about the process and to schedule an appointment. Waiver appointments will be available three working days **after** the date of the immigrant visa interview.

Waiver applicants may also purchase a Personal Identification Number (PIN) for \$10.00 USD from any Banamex Bank branch in Mexico and call 01-800-112-25-00. Please note it takes 24 hours for PIN activation.
