DOC's Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) administers the Commerce Control List (CCL) and is responsible for issuing licenses under the EAR. Information about EAR and how to apply for a license from BIS can be found at www.bis.doc.gov [2]. Specific information about EAR's requirements pertaining to the release of controlled technology can be found at www.bis.doc.gov/deemedexports[3].

DOS's Directorate of Defense Trade Controls (DDTC) administers the U.S. Munitions List (USML) and is responsible for issuing licenses under the ITAR. Information about the ITAR and how to apply for a license from DDTC can be found at www.pmdrtc.state.gov [4]. Specific information about the ITAR's requirements pertaining to the release of controlled technical data can be found at www.pmdrtc.state.gov/faqs/license_foreignpersons.html[5].
